

PREFACE



THAILAND

GEOGRAPHICAL STRUCTURES

Thailand is situated in Southeast Asia and has a land area of 513,115 square kilometers. It shares a border with Lao PDR and Cambodia at the east, and Malaysia and the Gulf of Thailand at the south. At the west are Myanmar and the Andaman Sea, and Myanmar and Lao PDR at the north.

WEATHER

Thailand has three main seasons. The summer months start around mid-February and end around mid-May. The rainy season begins around mid-May and lasts until mid-October. The cooler months are from mid-October to about mid-February. But since Thailand is situated in the tropical zone, the weather tends to be warm and humid year-round.







REGIONS

The National Research Council has separated regions within the country into six different parts according to their natural geographical structures; these include the North, Northeast,

Central, East, West and South. Each region differs in weather conditions, topography, culture, accent and some aspects.

THE NORTH

The northern region has a primarily hilly topography and is home to several top holiday destinations including Chiang Rai, Chiang Mai and Mae Hong Son. In the winter months, this area enjoys cool weather more than any other regions of Thailand, making it possible to grow certain fruits like lychees and strawberries. Being surrounded by mountains and having had a long


history of Lanna culture, the northern region is excellent for visitors wishing to experience beautiful, exotic culture.

THE NORTHEAST

Also known as I san, this region covers a total land area of 168,854 square kilometers or one third of the entire country. It consists largely of flat plains and some mountainous terrain with many natural attractions to enjoy like Phu Kradeung in

Loei or fields of wild flowers in Chaiyaphum.

Moreover, this area is home to many historical sites including the Ban Chiang Archaeological site in Udon Thani or Phu Faek Historical Park in Kalasin where footprints of large, carnivorous dinosaurs dating back 140 million years were found.





THE CENTRAL

The central part of Thailand is so fertile that it is known as 'the hub of food and water' of the country and also home to Bangkok, the country's capital. The terrain in the Central Region is mostly flat, with the Chao Phraya River-the lifeline of Thailand, running through it. This strategically ideal location also made Ayutthaya the chosen capital city of the kingdom overtwo hundred years ago.

THE EAST

Eastern Thailand has the most variety in topography: mountains, shorelines, islands and flat plains. There are several famous attractions here

including Pattaya in Chon Buri province, Lan Island, Kham Island, Sichang Island, Samet Island in Rayong province, Chang Island, Kut Island of Trat province and more.

THE WEST

The west covers 53,679 rais of land with the lengthy Tanaosri Mountain Range as a natural divider between Thailand and Myanmar. Outstanding provinces include Tak, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Phetchaburi and Prachuab Kiri Khan where visitors can enjoy important historical attractions like the Bridge of the River Kwai in Kanchanaburi or Khao Wang and Marukathaiyawan Palace in Phetchaburi. Also, not to be

missed are the beautiful, long, shallow beaches of Cha-Am, Hua Hin, Pranburi and Prachuab Kiri Khan.

THE SOUTH

The south is home many world famous tourist destinations like Phuket. Nga, Samui, Krabi, Phang Tao Island and a long list of other verdant islands almost everyone dreams of visiting. Both sides of the southern coast, the Andaman and the Gulf of Thailand, have its own magnetic quality that keeps visitors coming back again and again; a fact that catapulted tourism to the top of the country's income making industry.

With an exciting range of things to see and do, Thailand has slowly but surely become a top destination for holidaymakers around the world. And with the genuine friendliness of its people and the government's policy to


fully promote the tourism industry, spending a holiday in Thailand will leave visitors with the most memorable experience to cherish for a lifetime.





THAILAND AND ITS MULTICULTURAL SOCIETY

Thailand is ruled under a democratic form of government with the King as Head of State which allows its citizens the right to choose their own religious beliefs. Although the majority of Thais are Buddhists, there is no difference in treatment towards those from other

religions. Everyone can live together in harmony and run their businesses in the same society with equal opportunities.

The current population in Thailand is approximately 65 million with over 50 million being Buddhists and about 10 million being Muslims. And since everyone can respect and accept the differences in culture, it is easy and natural for Thais to genuinely welcome foreign cultures tourists bring with them.

Agood example of multicultural society can be found around the Nongjok District. It is located at the east side of Bangkok, bordering Chachoengsao and Pathumthani Provinces. Being the largest district in Bangkok with the majority of people being Muslims, this area also has the highest number of mosques in Bangkok. But the familiar sight of Buddhist temples standing alongside mosques and Chinese





merchants selling goods to Muslim clients can be seen every day as there are no boundaries between races. Another highlight of Nongjok District is its street food scene. During the Ramadan, both sides of the streets are lined with Halal food stalls during night time and mosques are beautifully lit with decorative lights as a celebration to this sacred period.

HIS MAJESTY THE KING AS THE UPHOLDER OF ALL RELIGIONS

Apart from the fact that Thailand has a law, which sustains the differences in religious beliefs, another important factor which keeps the morals of the people in tact is having His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej as the Upholder of all Religions. For the longest time, Thai kings have been the core of unity and respect among the Thai people even though the country is run within the framework of a Constitutional Monarchy with the Prime Minister as head of government.

To better serve and understand the customs and needs of all Muslims living in the country, a Head of the Muslims is appointed to conduct all Islamic affairs within the country, according to Section 6 in the Act of Parliament. Moreover, the King has shown his own support by initiating several projects including the publishing of the Koran in Thai language, refurbishment of mosques around the country and attending (or appointing a royal family member in his place) the Mawlid Ceremony. annual His genuine concern for the people, regardless of religion, has inevitably earned him love and respect by all.



THE CHULARJMONTRI (THE SHIEKHUL ISLAM)

The Chularajmontri is the leader of the Islamic religion in Thailand who provides advice to the Thai government, particularly the Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Culture, about Islamic affairs. According to the record of Somdet Phra Barom Trai Lok Nat (1448-1488) of the Ayutthaya period, it was said that the Chularajmontri existed but nobody knew who he was. It was only during the period of Somdet Phrachao Songtham

during 1620-1628 that His Excellency Sheika Ahmed was appointed by the king and thus became the first official Chularajmontri of Siam. For many generations after, the title was directly succeeded by those from the Sheika Ahmed's family, which was then made official by the king. But after Siam went under a period of political change, the Chularajmontri title is voted by members of the Islamic Council and the system has been kept until today.

THE CENTRAL ISLAMIC COUNCIL OF THAILAND

The Central Islamic Council of Thailand is an organization, which is a juristic person according to the law under the act of service to the Islamic Religion Organization of 1997. It was granted by His Majesty

King Bhumibol Adulyadej on October 17, 1997, with details stated in section 16 as follows:

There is to be a council with the title of 'Central Islamic Council of Thailand' with the Chularajmontri as chairman and a committee consisting of members selected from Islamic committees from different provinces and others which are selected by the Chularajmontri.



AUTHORITY OF THE CENTRAL ISLAMIC COUNCIL OF THAILAND

- 1.Offer advice to the Thai government, particularly the Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Culture, about regulations according to the Act.
- 2.Offer advice concerning the Islamic religion to the Islamic Committee of each province and Islamic Committees of mosques.
- 3.Set up subcommittees to carry out tasks issued by the Central Islamic Council of Thailand.
- 4.Set up rules concerning property management and profit-making for each province's Islamic Council and mosques.

- 5.Set rules of management for each province's Islamic Council and mosques.
- Act on behalf of the provinces, which do not have its own Islamic Council, or delegate the duty to a neighboring province, which has an Islamic Council.
- 7.Make decisions concerning petitions according to Section 41.
- 8.Manage the documentation and registration of properties and keep records of income and expenses for the Central Islamic Council of Thailand.

- Issue announcements and certify matters concerning the Islamic religion.
- 10.Promote Islamic religious activities and education.
- 11. Coordinate with the related government sectors concerning Islamic affairs.
- 12. Carry out other duties stated in this act.



THE SCIENCE
CENTER OF
HALAL AT
CHULALONGKORN
UNIVERSITY

The Science Center of Halal at Chulalongkorn University was initiated by Dr. Vinai Dahlan in 1995 in a small lab within the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences. Its purpose was to develop halal forensic science for the benefit of Muslim and non-Muslim consumers. The small lab continuously expanded until it was recognized as the world's first science center of halal.

The center constantly made developments in science and technology of halal, covering different branches in the field, which earned it many awards at an international level. Now, its main aim is to ensure physical and mental well-being of Muslim consumers in Thailand and around the world in accordance with the concept of 'Religiously and scientifically Qualified'.

STANDARD HALAL FOOD AND SERVICES FOR TOURISM

The standard for halal food and services for tourism has been issued by the Ministry of Tourism and Sports in conjunction with the Central Islamic Council of Thailand since 2007. For several years. studies and evaluations have been made, and it was concluded that certain standards must be met in order to receive certification by the Council. However, getting the certification is not compulsory although it will serve as a guide for Muslim tourists to take advantage of the services more conveniently. It will also raise the standard for tourism and ensure no shortages of halal restaurants for travelers.

Of course, the fundamental rules of handling halal food is strictly practiced by all venues from choosing the right ingredients to food preparation according to the Islamic religion. In general, visitors can enjoy dining in restaurants with 'Full Halal Certification', or venues which are 'Muslim-friendly' as they are also halal restaurants, which have no certification. Moreover, there are 'Halal Basic Standard' venues, which entail all eleven qualifications according to the Islamic religion and the 'Law and Voluntary Standard' venues which are places governed by the ninetyfive rules of the law. Visitors will, therefore, have full confidence in consuming safe and delicious halal food during their travels in Thailand.









A major concern for people while traveling overseas sickness and accidents. This is particularly important for Muslim travelers since the method of treatment must not conflict with their religion including setting up of an associate, the use of black magic or alcoholic substances and other means.

Today, several hospitals in Thailand have sufficiently set up facilities to cater to Muslim patients from the Middle East and other Muslim countries. By the year 2017, the Ministry of Health has plans for 50 hospitals in the Southern region to incorporate a 100% standard halal kitchen for the benefit of local citizens who are mainly Muslims.

At the moment, 35 hospitals have passed the standard, which makes up 70 percent of the total goal.


A good example of a standard halal kitchen can be found in Satun Hospital, which received high ratings from patients and their families. Surveys show that they are satisfied and have confidence in the Hospital's food by up to 95.22%. The Hospital's further plan, then, is to apply for a standard halal certification and create halal menus that are beneficial for health, such as, low-fat rotis and health tea. Moreover, it will provide guidance to subsidiary hospitals and business operators who wish to develop their halal food standard.

- 1. Foreigners who wish to travel to Thailand must apply for an entry visa at the Thai Embassy or Consulate in their country of residence, or a Thai Embassy assigned to that country. Further information can be obtained from all Thai Embassies or the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 2. There are two groups of passport holders of certain nationals that are eligible to travel into the Kingdom of Thailand without an entry visa according to the agreement.
- 1) Citizens of countries who are exempted from obtaining a tourist entry visa are entitled to remain in the Kingdom for no more than 30 days.
- 2) Countries whose citizens do not require an entry visa into Thailand if they hold a specific type of passport including a diplomat passport, government official's passport or other types listed in the agreement.

- 3. Certain nationals are eligible for a visa on arrival and can remain in Thailand for 15 days or less.
- 4. Foreigners traveling from countries with a Yellow Fever Outbreak must show an International Health Certification on Yellow Fever Vaccination.
- 5. Requirement for a visa application into Thailand
- Passport with a minimum of 6 months prior to expiration.
- Documents to prove that the visitor will return to their country or the next destination (return ticket and visa).
- The traveler must not be an individual banned from entering the Kingdom according to the Immigration Act of 1979. He/she may be required to show a minimum amount of cash, (for instance 20,000 THB.) for expenses incurred while residing in the Kingdom.

- 6. The purpose visit must coincide with the visa application.
- 7. Travelers must check their visa validity and period of stay before entering Thailand to avoid complications. A fine of 500 THB. is charged per person per day of overstay. For more information, please call Tel. 02 141 9889 or log on to the website at 'www.bangkok. immigration.go.th'.
- 8. Foreign nationals traveling into the Kingdom are not allowed to work in the country without a work permit. For more information, please log onto the Ministry of Labour's website at www.mol.go.th.
- who have 9. Foreigners received an entry visa into the Kingdom by the Thai Embassy or Consulate may be refused entry by the Immigration Department if he/she is found to be in conflict with the Immigration Act of 1979.

> AYUTTHAYA

Just less than two hour's drive north of Bangkok, Ayutthaya is famous for its fascinating ancient ruins. Before the kingdom became known as

Thailand, this ancient city was once the capital of Siam up until the late 1700s when it was destroyed by invading Burmese troops.

BANGKOK

A melting pot of diverse cultures, the capital city of Thailand offers endless wonders for travelers. The biggest concentration of Arab halal restaurants can be found in Soi Nana or Sukhumvit Soi 3 and this area offers accommodation, which is very popular among visitors from the Middle East.

> CHIANG MAI

A true gem of the north, Chiang Mai is a destination not to be missed for those wishing to catch a glimpse of the Lanna culture. This charming province is filled with unique traditions and offers endless cultural attractions, shopping, handicrafts and a long list of things to do for visitors.

CHIANG RAI

This northernmost province kingdom, which steadily been gaining has popularity among travelers, is

also steeped in Lanna culture. Among its many attractions are Doi Tung and the Golden Triangle.

> CHON BURI

Home to Pattaya City, a world famous seaside town where visitors from every corner of the world have come to love, Chon Buri is teaming with facilities to cater to the halal market. It is very popular

many reasons-amazing modern facilities, beaches. diverse dining opportunities, shopping and entertainment. Also, the less-than-two-hour drive from Bangkok makes it even more convenient to visit.

> KHON KAEN

The fifth largest Northeastern province, KhonKaen is known for its fine Mudmee silk and natural-dved cotton. Also, there are plenty of natural attractions, caves and national

park including Phu Wiang National Park with dinosaur fossils and ancient civilization

> KRABI

This southern province located on the Andaman coast is known around the world for its beautiful beaches and dreamy islands. Home to some

150 islands, Krabi has become one of the most sought-after seaside destinations for holidaymakers around the world for more than two decades.

NAKHON RATCHASIMA

Also known as Khorat, this province is located at the end of the Khorat Plateau. It is also the gateway to Isan or

the Northeastern provinces of Thailand who speak a Laotian dialect.

NAKHON SI THAMMARAT

Located on the west side of the Gulf of Thailand, it is the second largest province of the South. Back in ancient times,

this area was part of the Ligor Kingdom and an important center of historical Buddhism.

> PHANG NGA

Also a beautiful and picturesque southern province of Thailand teaming with fertile natural attractions, Phang Nga is home to a large Muslim community who were originally fishermen. A fascinating

example is the local inhabitants of Ko Panyi, an island originally built on stilts. Their ancestors were seafaring fishermen who came from Java during the 18th century.

PHETCHABURI

Considered as the 'Gateway to the South', this extremely popular royal seaside town offers long, beautiful shorelines and pony rides on the beach. Among its numerous

historical landmarks is Khao Wang, a palace compound built during the reign of King Rama 4. Not to be missed are traditional Thai sweets that are indigenous to the area.

PHUKET

The largest island in Thailand dubbed as 'the Pearl of the Andaman', Phuket is undoubtedly one of the best known tourist destinations in Thailand. It offers endless

verdant beaches and natural attractions while at the same time booming with shopping opportunities, diverse dining options, entertainment and excellent accommodation.

SATUN

Sharing a border with Malaysia, it is not surprising that the majority of Satun's population are descents of Malaysian Muslims. This peaceful province is home to Tarutao and Lipe Islands, which are

breath-taking and much less touristy than Phuket and Krabi. The city's night market is a great place to browse around, and it is where you can find an array of halal street food.

> SONGKHLA
